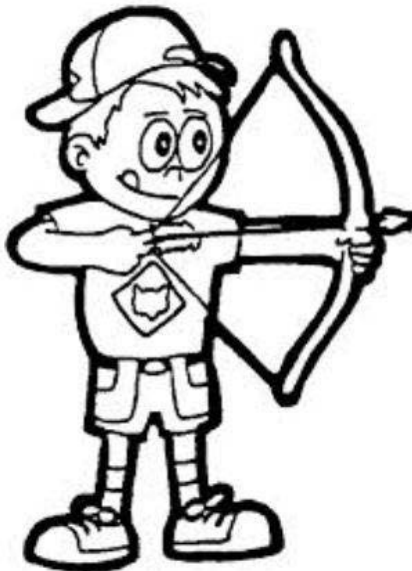


Scouts will learn outdoor skills, shoot archery and BB guns, play sports, earn advancements, make crafts, and more.
